Chronological List of Battles

There are too many historical, or quasi-historical, events in my book to include them all in a chronology. Rather than trying to decide which were the most important, I have instead restricted the class of events in this chronology, to wars, battles, and sieges. Even then, to keep the numbers down, I have included only those which are clearly relevant to the Matter of Britain (367–658), and for which at least one commander is named. In this list I use modern orthography for names, and modern place names, where known. Places names in the sources with no known modern equivalent are given in brackets [like this]. The abbreviations used are hopefully obvious. A numerical subscript is used to distinguish different individuals of the same name, even if the name is not given in precisely the same form.

 - 638 Oswald (Brytenwalda) captures Edinburgh from the Gododdin.
 - 641 Penda (K. Mid. Angles) defeats Eadric in his K.dom of E. Anglia.
- c.641 Cynddylan (K. Pengwern) defeats Mercians at Lichfield.
 - 642 Oswald & Eowa (K. Mercia) defeated by Penda & Britons at Maserfield.
 - 645 Penda defeats Cenwealh (Cynegil's son) and occupies Wessex.
 - 651 Penda besieges Oswiu (Oswald's bro., K. Bernicia) at Bamburgh.
